He will not sustain the healthy, but he will devour the flesh of the fat sheep and tear off their hooves. ¹⁷ Woe to the worthless shepherd who deserts the flock! May a sword strike his arm and his right eye! May his arm wither away and his right eye go completely blind!”

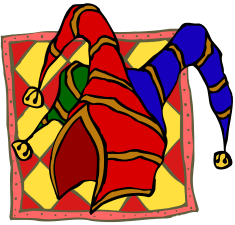

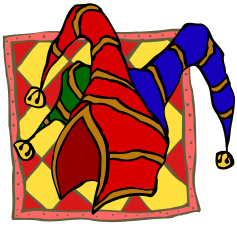

Also, a “foolish shepherd will devour the flesh of the fat sheep and tear off their hooves” (Zechariah 11:16 HCSB). Today in America we do not bring an animal for sacrifice to a priest, but these words have meaning for us now. The meaning of “... devour the flesh of the fat sheep...” (Zechariah 11:16 HCSB) is the foolish shepherd taking the people’s money and material until they have none. It is the indication of the foolish shepherd misusing the offerings and tithes for his or her monetary gain. The foolish shepherd is overwhelming the individual or congregation with non-spiritual events and programs that are leading them down the wide and spacious road. Although the road seems wide and spacious in the beginning, later the road will become dark and dangerous because of the lust desires to please the flesh. Because the foolish shepherds are not speak Spiritual loving and healing words from the Holy Bible, but instead promoting C.M.E (commercializing of merchandise and events), the heavenly Hosts of the LORD GOD Almighty and His Holy Spirit is not present in the place of worship.
